- 7. Principal's Report
 - We have our first walkthrough on Wednesday, September 11. The purpose of the walkthrough is to assess our current instructional practices to identify

- opportunities for improvement. The participants include the Chief and staff of Network 1, school administration, and teachers.
- Teachers participated in a full day training on the new reading program. We have been collaboratively planning in team meetings, and we will hold another training session during the September 27 professional development day.
- Students are currently taking the iReady and Star 360 Reading and Math assessments. We will use this information to determine which students need intervention and create our Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) Tiers. All students are in Tier 1, Tier 2 is additional support, and Tier 3 is intensive support.
- The social emotional theme for September is Panther Pride.
- Our current enrollment is 612 students, 29 more students than last year. We are experiencing some full and overcrowded classrooms (Kindergarten, 1st, 3rd, and 7th grades). We have raised the concern, and we expect more guidance in the coming days about the process for reporting and requesting additional assistance.
- Our overall attendance rate for the year is 96.67%, compared to 95.54% at this time last year, with all grades except for PreK finishing above the 95% threshold.
- We have collected \$18,670 in Student Fees so far, compared with \$20,730 at this time last year.
- The Scholastic Book Fair is next week: September 17 & 18.
